Deegan was diagnosed with Acute Myelogenous Leukemia in March 2016 when he was 3 years old. Soon after, doctors determined he needed a bone marrow transplant. Chase Stigall, a former college basketball player at Butler University, was moved to be a part of the Be The match program because one of his teammates lost his life to cancer. Just a few months after he submitted his sample through the Be The Match Registry, Stigall was matched to Deegan. Fortunately, Deegan was matched quickly to a donor and Deegan can now say he's been in remission for one year as of Aug. 10th, 2017.
